To be the leading provider of fruit varieties in the world, using natural breeding practices to provide consumers with an incredible eating experience.



FG's Commercial team works in collaboration with our Quality Assurance, Technical and Research & Development teams to provide unparalleled levels of service to our licensees, and boost promotional efforts of IFG varieties, brands, and trademarks in the global marketplace. The team works to showcase IFG's varieties, working alongside retailers and licensed marketers globally to achieve feedback.

he Commercial team works on the business operations side, utilizing data integration and analytics processes to support IFG's licensing model and our licensee's ability to make confident decisions to expand in partnership with IFG. Our Commercial Managers monitor the table grape industry, assessing the market and opportunities within it, providing our Licensees with the best table grape expertise in the world.

he scope of the IFG Technical Team is to provide tailored support to the licensed growers based on our knowledge of the IFG varieties in combination with the local growing conditions, in terms of climate, soil, labor availability/skills and final market targets. Collaboration with IFG Licensees in the vineyards is essential to achieving the best results for each table grape variety.

hen a new table grape variety is introduced to a different environment, IFG's Technical team observes and studies them in order to define the most appropriate practices needed to achieve the best quality fruit in that region. Commercial field testing and experimentation is necessary to gain knowledge on each variety's potential. The IFG Technical team is fully involved with this process, from test block observations to semi-commercial trials. Each IFG grower is supported by a dedicated team who shares a global knowledge on how to grow IFG table grape varieties under different conditions.

he IFG Quality Assurance team's mission is to ensure our global network of Licensees produce consistent quality. Utilizing custom inspection reports, IFG is able to track fruit quality during the harvest season. Quality requirements are variety specific for individual regions and consider local growing conditions upon inspection. IFG works with our growers to maximize flavor and appearance to express the full potential of each variety.

resources in the main destination markets to understand and evaluate fruit on arrival to the final consumer.

Our team visits importers and exporters to receive feedback, and visits retail stores to inspect fruit quality, monitor trademark compliance and labeling, as well as identify any illegal fruits through DNA testing.




